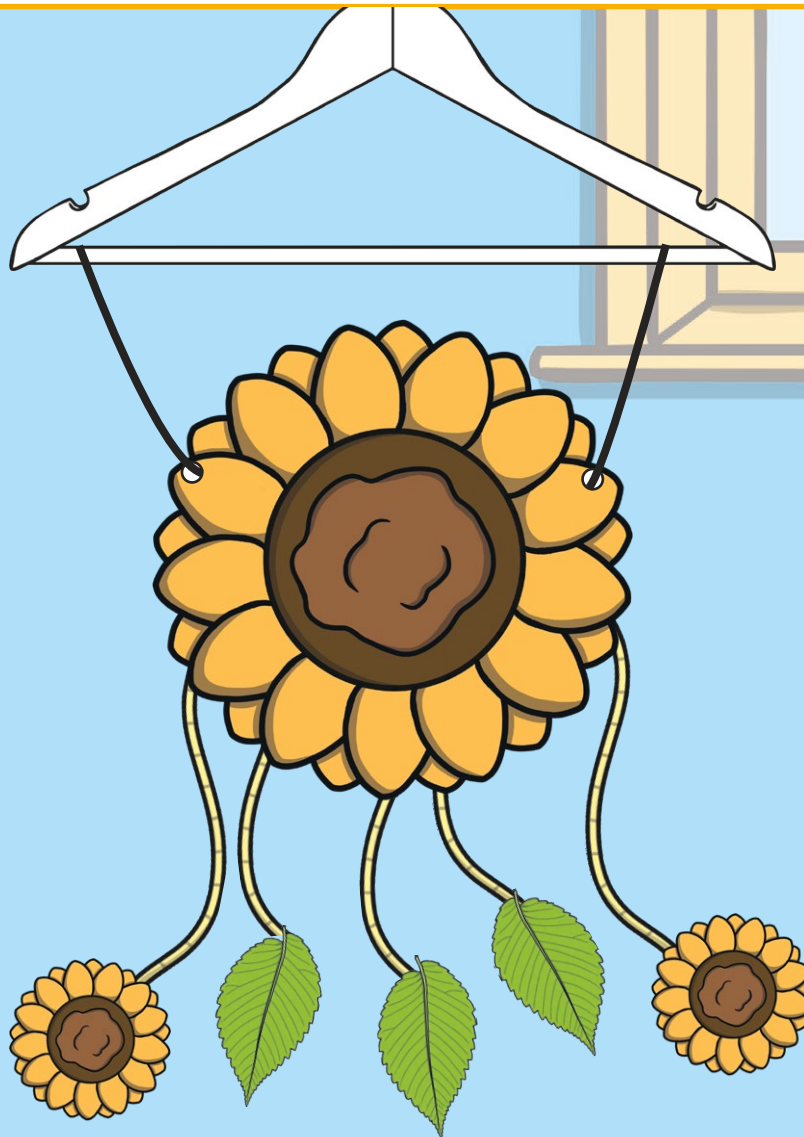
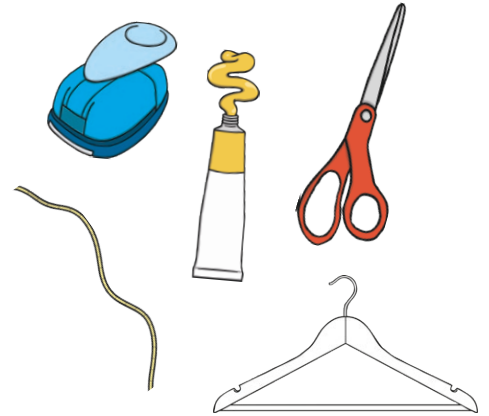


Sunflower Mobile Craft

Supplies:

- paint
- paint brushes
- scissors
- string
- template page
- hole punch
- clothes hanger





Instructions

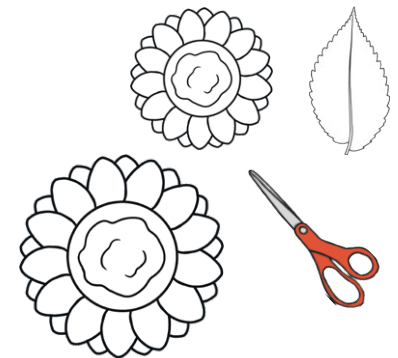
Step 1

Set up your craft space and pop on your apron or old clothing. Make sure you have all your craft supplies and a printout of the template pages.



Step 2

Cut out the larger sunflower, the smaller sunflowers and the leaves from the template pages provided.



Step 3

Paint your sunflowers using yellow and brown paint. Paint your leaves using red, orange or green paint. Make sure to use a new paint brush for every new colour paint that you use.



Step 4

Once the paint has dried, carefully create 5 holes on the petals of the lower half of your large sunflower, using a hole punch. This is where your smaller sunflowers and leaves will hang from.

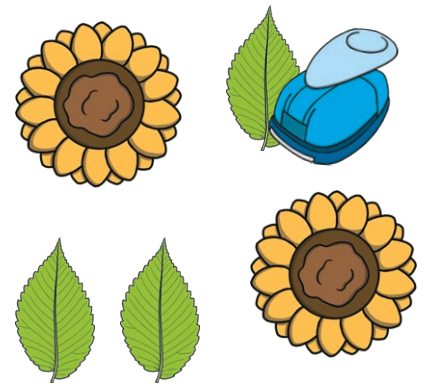

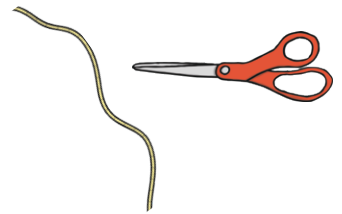
Step 5

Carefully punch a hole at the top of the remainder of the sunflowers and leaves, ready to thread your string.



Step 6

Using scissors, carefully cut your string into 6 pieces, ready to bring your mobile together.



Twinkl Top Tip: You can cut different lengths of string to make your flowers and leaves move in the wind at different heights on the mobile.

Step 7

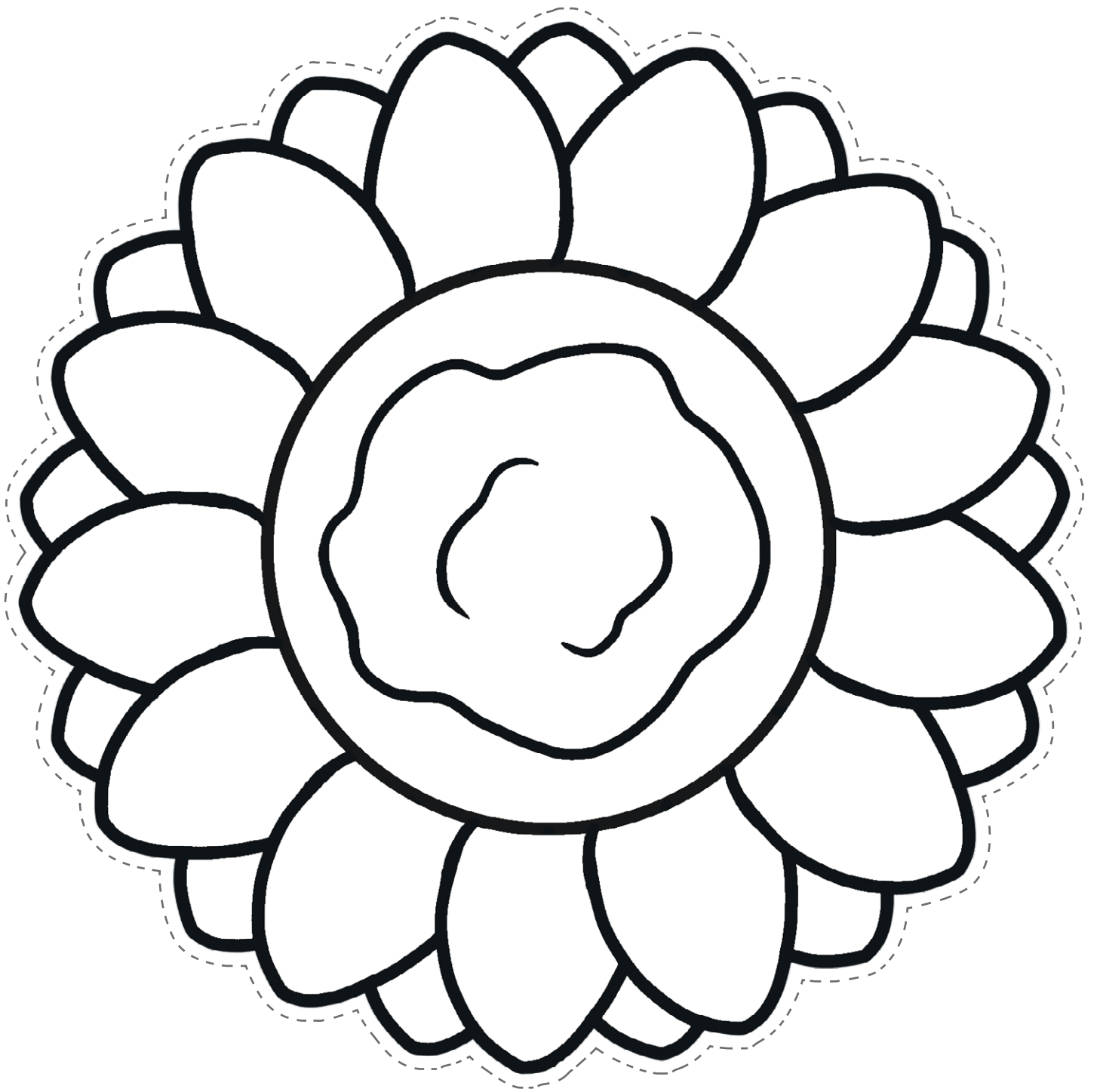
Pull pieces of string through the punched holes and attach the smaller sunflowers and leaves to the larger sunflower.



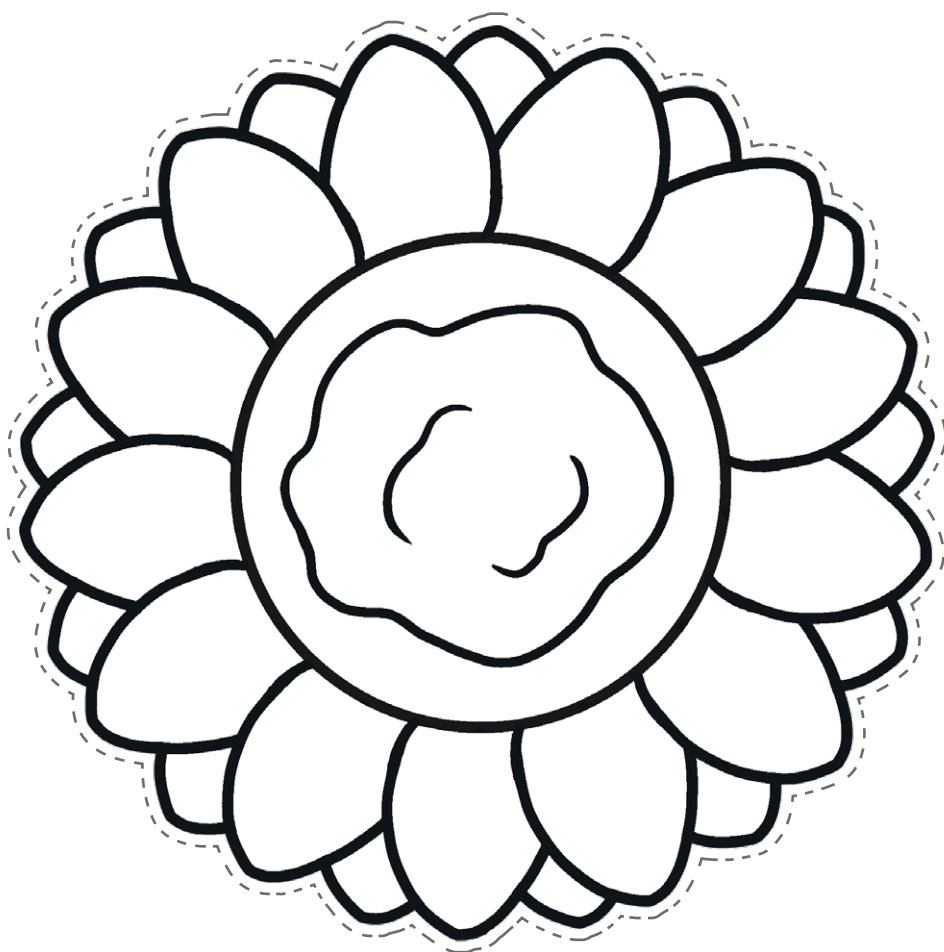
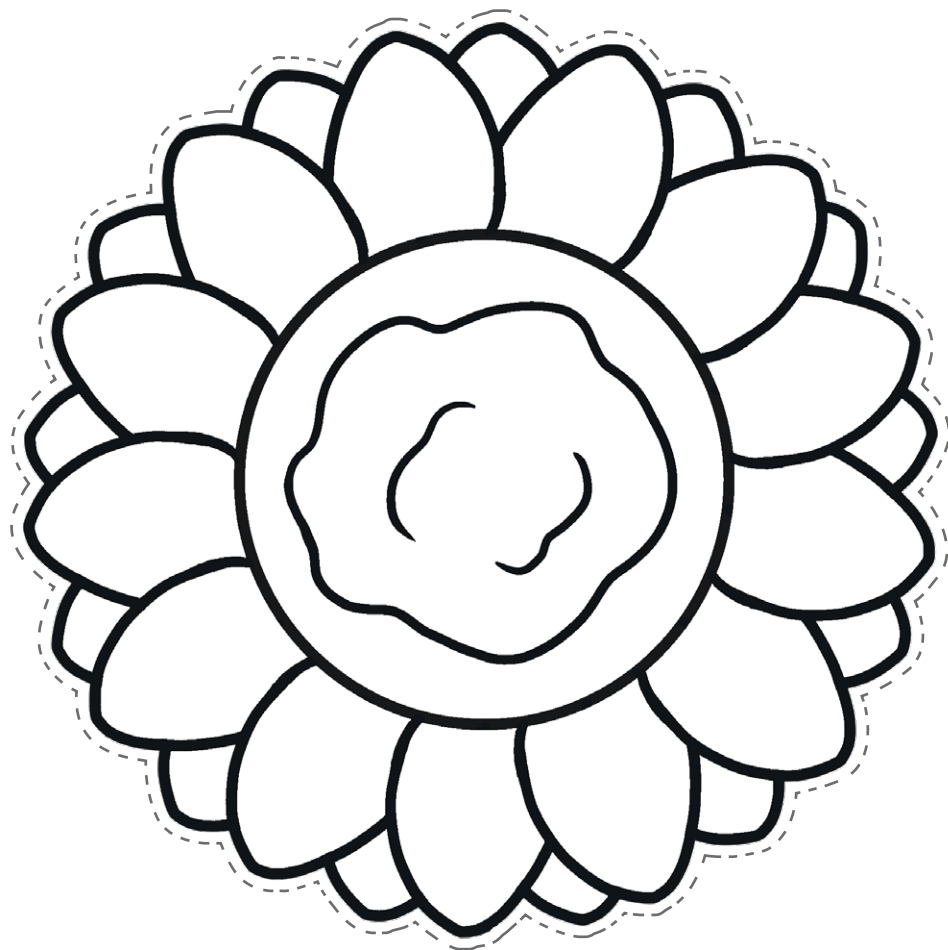
Step 8

Make two holes on two of the petals at the top of your larger sunflower. Pull a larger piece of string through the two holes and tie the two ends of the string around a clothes hanger.

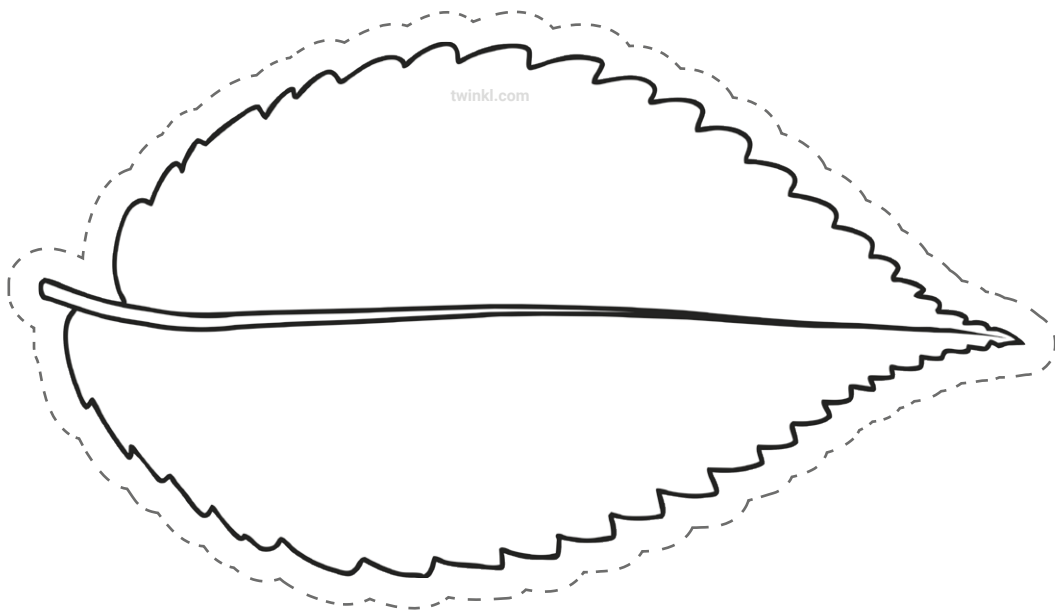
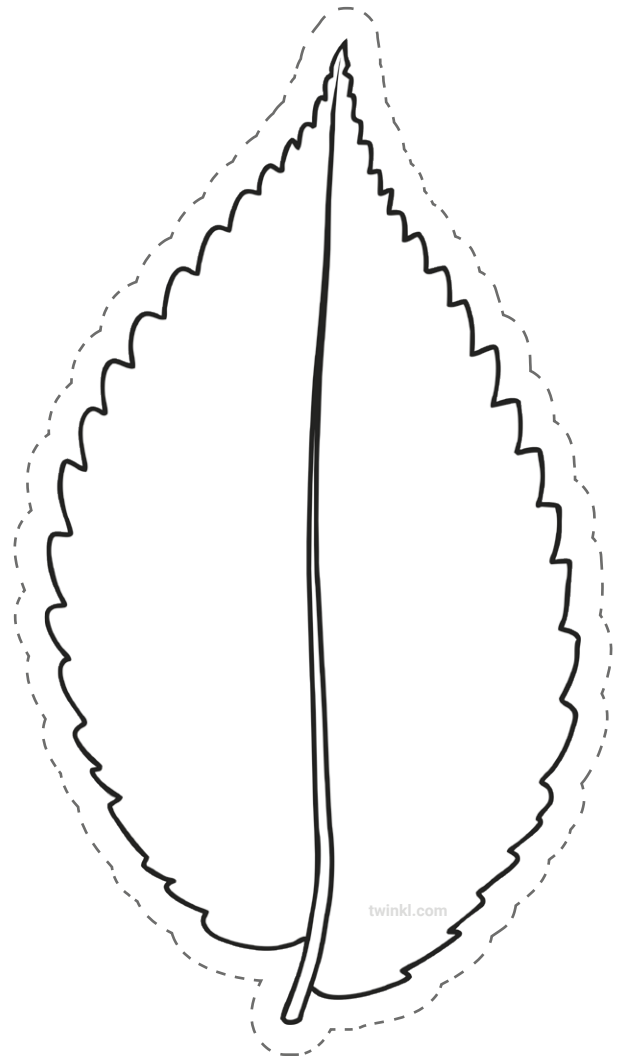
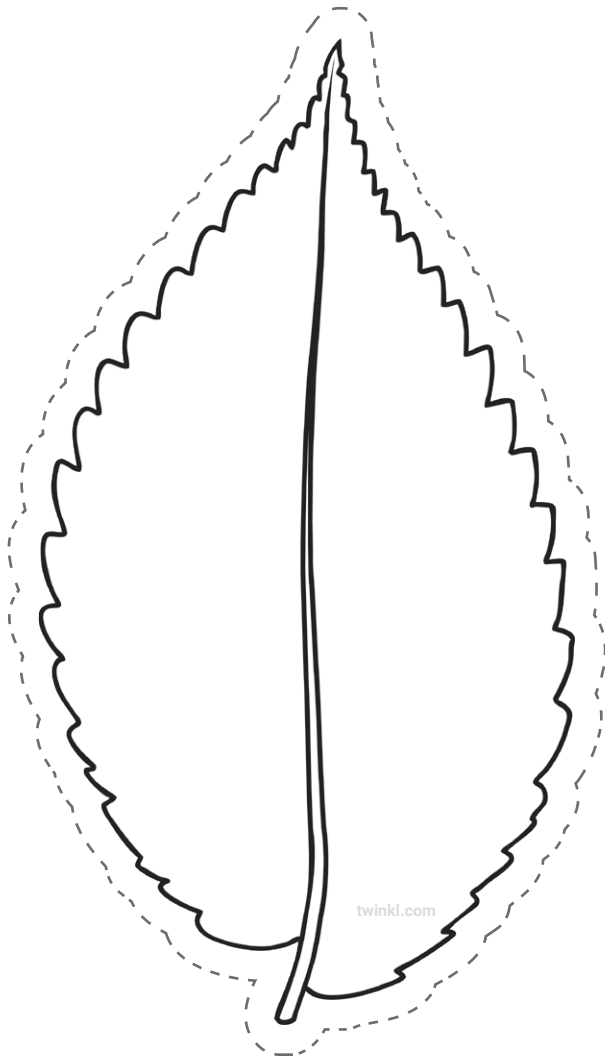




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
